These programs will be approved by the Scientific Advisory Committee in the fall of 2011. CRM will also collaborate with other centers, including GERAD, CIRANO, CIRRELT inside NCM2, in the organization of 2-3 additional workshops on themes related to the management of renewable resources, etc. CRM will organize some colloquium talks for researchers in mathematical sciences on MPE subjects during 2013, one or two public lectures related to MPE 2013. In collaboration with ISM, CRM will produce one special MPE issue of the magazine *Accromath*, which is distributed freely in the Quebec high schools. CRM has invited the Quebec associations of mathematics teachers to hold their 2013 congress on the theme of MPE. It has approached FQRNT (Fonds québécois de la recherche sur la nature et les technologies, research funding agency in Quebec) so that FQRNT holds its 2013 research day on MPE. CRM will be hosting the December 2012 Canadian Mathematical Society Meeting where MPE 2013 will be launched in Canada.
