

## CRM research visits for French scientists

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**Montreal, August 17, 2017.** - The Institute of Mathematics of the CNRS (INSMI) offers French researchers a number of mechanisms for medium and long-term visits to a CNRS Unité Mixte Internationale (UMI).

- 1) Researchers may be posted to the UMI.
- 2) Researchers may keep their French laboratory posting and have their mission supported from UMI funds.
- 3) Researchers may keep their French laboratory posting and have their mission supported from their laboratory funds and/or from INSMI funds.

The first two options offer more support for the researcher but the number of positions of this type is extremely limited.

For visits during the academic year 2018-2019 or (for CNRS researchers) during the calendar year 2018, applications must be sent by November 15, 2017, to INSMI International [insmi.international@cnrs.fr](mailto:insmi.international@cnrs.fr), and should be cc'd to à Jean-Stéphane DHERSIN ([Jean-Stephane.DHERSIN@cnrs.fr](mailto:Jean-Stephane.DHERSIN@cnrs.fr)) and the co-directors of UMI 3457, Emmanuel Giroux and Luc Vinet, at [crmfrance@crm.umontreal.ca](mailto:crmfrance@crm.umontreal.ca).

Requests should consist of the following documents:

- a CV and a list of publications;
- a (short) scientific project for the stay in the UMI;
- the estimated dates of stay in the UMI.

Dossiers will be considered in December 2017 and the decisions communicated at the beginning of 2018.

Note:

- French researchers assigned to a UMR belonging to a CNRS institute other than INSMI (such as INS2I, INP, INSIS, ...) should contact their own institute, which may have a different timetable and procedure. However, they should also inform INSMI and the UMI director.

- For posting to the UMI (option 1 above), it is necessary to hold a position and, for those with teaching positions, to obtain a delegation to the CNRS. It is therefore essential to also file a request for delegation to the CNRS, according to whatever deadlines are set by the home university.

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
