## **Public transport in Montreal**

Bus/metro from \$3.25 (*exact fare necessary*). Metro and busses run from 5:30 in the morning until 00:30 am (metro line 5/blue line, serving the Université de Montréal runs until 23:00 only); frequency of trains and busses is good.
